

## **BIOGRAPHY FOR REVEREND DR. ALBERT WINN, PARISH ASSOCIATE**

The Reverend Dr. Albert C. Winn has served the Presbyterian Church as teacher, author, pastor, moderator, and seminary president. A graduate of Davidson College, and Union and Princeton seminaries, he served congregations in Virginia and Georgia. He taught at Stillman College in Alabama and at Louisville Presbyterian Seminary, where he also served as President. He was elected Moderator of the 1979 General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church. He headed the committee that wrote "A Declaration of Faith", a confession of faith widely used in our denomination. An advocate for peace and justice in the church and in the world, he has worked for civil rights and equal opportunity for women. He founded the Covenant Network in Salem Presbytery, which seeks to preserve the unity of the church while at the same time striving for full inclusion of gay and lesbian Presbyterians. He and his late wife Grace have four children, including Grace Ellis of our congregation, and five grandchildren.
